- Article 1 National Taiwan University Office of Student Affairs, Health Center ("the Health Center") formulates the NTU *Directives for Medical Equipment Borrowing* ("the Directives") to establish the borrowing and managing system for medical equipment such as first-aid kits, crutches, and wheelchairs of the Health Center.
- Article 2 The borrowing and returning of medical equipment shall be done within the office hour of the Health Center.
- Article 3 The items for borrowing, the required identifications, and the period for borrowing are listed in Table 1.
- Article 4 When borrowing medical equipment from the Health Center, the borrower shall have either one of the eligible IDs listed in Table 1 retained at the Health Center, which will be returned by the Health Center after the borrowed items are returned.

The Health Center may forbid borrowers to borrow medical equipment for six months if they fail to return the borrowed items within the required time.

When using medical equipment borrowed from the Health Center, borrowers shall carefully keep, maintain, and, if damaged, repair the borrowed items; if such damages are not possible to repair or the item is destroyed, the borrower shall provide a new one or compensate at the market price within the time informed by the Health Center.

Article 5 The Directives shall be passed by the Administrative Meeting and then implemented on the date of promulgation.
