- Article 1 Article 1 The National Taiwan University (NTU or “the University”) Center for General Education (“the Center”) *Standards for Reductions in Professional Seniority Required for Specialists in the Athletic Department* (“the Standards”) are set in accordance with Article 8 of the Center’s *Directives for Appointments of Specialists as Instructors by the Athletic Department* to handle matters related to reductions in professional seniority required for specialists in the Athletic Department (“the Department”).
- Article 2 Specialists in the Department who are winners of the Ministry of Education’s National Guo Guang Athletic Medal may be granted a reduction in required professional seniority (see Appendix for details).
- Article 3 Those with extraordinary achievements other than winning the National Guo Guang Athletic Medal may be eligible for a reduction in the required professional seniority following review and approval by the Department, Center, and University Faculty Evaluation Committees.
- Article 4 The Standards shall be passed by the Department Affairs Meeting and the Center Affairs Meeting and then implemented on the date of promulgation.

Notes:

1. The above standards for reduction in required professional seniority for winners of major international awards have been set in accordance with the *Regulations Governing the Issuance of Guo Guang Athletic Medals and Scholarships*.
2. The following conditions shall apply in the recognition of professional seniority:
 - 1) For achievements obtained as a coach, the recognition of professional seniority shall be based on the candidate's actual seniority as a coach.

- 2) For achievements obtained as an athlete, the recognition of professional seniority shall begin accruing from the candidate's first appearance in an official international championship event.
