- Article 1 The National Taiwan University (NTU or “the University”) Center for General Education (“the Center”) Athletic Department (“the Department”) formulates the *NTU Directives Governing Faculty Appointments and Reviews by Athletic Department* (“the Directives”) in accordance with Article 8, Paragraph 1 of the *NTU Guidelines Governing the Establishment of the Faculty Evaluation Committee of Each Department, Division, Graduate Institute, Degree Program, Office, and Center*.
- Article 2 Matters related to the qualifications of and publication reviews for applicants seeking a faculty position at the Department shall be subject to the applicable provisions of the *Act Governing the Appointment of Educators*, the *Regulations Governing Accreditation of Teacher Qualifications at Junior Colleges and Institutions of Higher Education*, the University’s *Guidelines Governing the Initial Appointments of Full-Time Faculty Members by Each College and Center and Directives for Appointing Part-time Faculty Members*, and the Center’s *Specific Rules for Faculty Appointment Reviews*.
- Article 3 Applicants seeking a faculty position at the Department shall submit the required documents and a teaching/research proposal in accordance with the requirements set forth under the University’s regulations governing the list of full-time and part-time faculty members pending appointment for faculty appointment reviews.
- Article 4 The Department's Faculty Evaluation Committee (“the Committee”) shall conduct faculty appointment reviews in two phases: a preliminary review followed by a secondary review.
- The Committee shall conduct a preliminary review of the qualifications and specializations of faculty members whose appointments are pending. Those who pass the preliminary review shall be referred to the Center for a publication review.
- Upon completion of the publication review by the Center, the Committee shall conduct a secondary review. Those who pass the secondary review shall be referred to the Center’s Faculty Evaluation Committee for deliberation.
- Article 5 Matters not addressed herein shall be subject to the applicable regulations of

Article 6 The Directives shall be passed by the Department Affairs Meeting, Center Affairs Meeting, and Administrative Meeting and then implemented on the date of promulgation.
