

**NATIONAL TAIWAN UNIVERSITY**  
**Regulations for the Management of Sports Venues on the**  
**Main Campus**

August 05, 2020    Amendment proposed and passed by the 2<sup>nd</sup> Sports Venue Oversight Committee meeting, Academic Year 2019–20  
September 01, 2020    Discussed and passed by the 3,076<sup>th</sup> Administrative Meeting

- Article 1    National Taiwan University (NTU or “the University”) formulates the *NTU Regulations for the Management of Sports Venues on the Main Campus* (“the Regulations”) to enhance professionalism, teaching, research, and service in the field of physical education and to strengthen the management of the NTU Sports Center and other sports venues on the main campus.
- Article 2    The scope of the term “sports venues” as used herein shall include all sports venues, fields, and ancillary facilities on the Main Campus which are managed by the Athletic Department (“the Department”).
- Article 3    Sports venues may be used for the following purposes:
1.    Physical Education teaching and research
  2.    Training of the University’s sports delegations
  3.    Activities organized by or for NTU faculty, staff, and students
  4.    Other activities which do not interfere with the uses described above, as approved in accordance with the applicable administrative procedures
- Article 4    The Sports Venue Oversight Committee (“the Committee”) is established to ensure the effective oversight of sports venue management. The Committee shall be composed of 13 members including the NTU President, an Executive Vice President, the Secretary-General, the Vice President for Academic Affairs, the Vice President for Student Affairs, the Vice President for General Affairs, the Director of the Center for General Education, the Director of the Accounting Office, the Dean of the Department, 2 professor representatives (to be appointed by the NTU President), and 2 professional sports representatives (one of whom shall be an external member; both to be nominated by the Department). Members shall serve a one-year term without compensation. The NTU President shall serve as the convener, and the Dean of the Department as executive secretary.
- The Committee shall convene at least once per semester, and interim meetings may be called when necessary. The Committee shall invite two student representatives, as well as other stakeholders, to attend meetings as non-voting delegates.
- Article 5    NTU faculty, staff, students, sports delegations, clubs, and non-NTU units that wish to organize activities/events at any sports venue shall first obtain the approval of the competent unit(s) of the University and shall comply with the provisions set forth in the applicable enforcement rules and regulations governing the University’s sports venues.
- Article 6    Renters who are found to have violated any of the following subparagraphs may have their rental suspended or terminated by the management personnel of the sports venue in question or, if necessary, may be expelled from the

premises by the management personnel or Campus Security:

1. Using a sports venue in a manner that is inconsistent with the objectives of the event or detrimental to public order or good morals.
2. Using a sports venue in a manner that is contrary to the spirit of education or detrimental to public welfare.
3. Engaging in unlawful or unsanctioned assembly that is detrimental to public order
4. Using a sports venue for a purpose that is inconsistent with the contents indicated on the event proposal; changing the event organizer without authorization
5. Causing safety concerns; causing or likely to cause damage to the facilities of the sports venue in question
6. Using a sports venue for political assemblies or to campaign for a political party

Article 7 Sports venue users shall exercise due care in using the equipment located at sports venues, and shall indemnify the Department for any damage caused to it. Users or renters shall bear sole legal liability for any harm or injury caused to others.

Article 8 The enforcement rules for the Regulations and other associated rules shall be formulated by the Department, passed by the Committee, and then implemented.

Article 9 The Regulations shall be passed by the Committee and the Administrative Meeting and then implemented on the date of promulgation.
