Article 1 The National Taiwan University (NTU or “the University”) Center for General Education hereby establishes the Center for Teacher Education (“the Center”) in accordance with Article 27 of the University’s *Organizational Charter*, Article 6 of the *Teacher Education Act*, and Article 2 of the *Regulations for Establishing Teacher Training Centers by Universities* to handle matters related to the Secondary School Teacher Education Program (“the Program”).

Article 2 The duties of the Center shall include the planning and coordination of teacher education courses offered by related academic programs and colleges, as well as the administration of Program-related tasks.

Article 3 The Program’s faculty members shall include full- and part-time faculty members appointed or jointly appointed by the Center, as well as supporting faculty members from other academic programs.

The Program shall have at least five full-time faculty members whose field of expertise corresponds with the subject area they teach in.

The Center shall organize a University-wide open recruitment and selection process for initial appointments of jointly appointed faculty members and supporting faculty members from other academic programs. Regulations governing faculty selection, joint appointments, and appointment renewals shall be formulated separately.

The Center may appoint additional full- or part-time faculty members in the event that there are an insufficient number of jointly appointed faculty members and supporting faculty members from other academic programs to meet curricular needs. The appointment of full- and part-time faculty members shall be subject to the applicable faculty review regulations.

- Article 4 The Center shall have a director (“the Director”) to oversee its operations. The Director, who shall be a full-time NTU faculty member with a rank of associate professor higher, shall be appointed by the President of the University at the recommendation of the Director of the Center for General Education. The term of the Director shall be three years, with the possibility of up to two consecutive terms.
- Article 5 The Center shall establish three functional divisions—the Education Division, Practical Training Division, and Administrative Division—each with a director and several staff members.
- Article 6 The Center shall establish a curriculum committee, a faculty review committee, and an admissions committee. The committees shall be composed of the Center’s full-time faculty members and jointly appointed faculty members.
- The Center may establish other committees to address its official needs.
- The stipulations for the establishment of the committees described in the preceding two paragraphs shall be passed by the Center for General Education’s General Education Committee, reported to the University for approval and reference, and then implemented.
- Article 7 The Center shall have the pedagogical materials, professional educational journals, and teaching/research instruments and equipment mandated by the *Regulations for Establishing Teacher Training Centers by Universities*.
- Article 8 Matters not addressed herein shall be subject to the *Teacher Education Act*, the NTU *Organizational Charter*, and other applicable laws and University regulations.
- Article 9 The Regulations shall be passed by the University Council, reported to the Ministry of Education for approval, and then implemented on the date of promulgation.
