Article 1 The Center for Teacher Education (“the Center”) under the Center for General Education, National Taiwan University (“the University”) formulates *the Regulations Governing the Selection, Joint Appointment, and Appointment Renewal of Jointly Appointed and Supporting Faculty Members* (“the Regulations”) in accordance with Article 3, Paragraph 2 of the Center for General Education’ s *Regulations Governing the Establishment of the Center for Teacher Education*.

Article 2 The term “jointly appointed faculty members” refers to full-time faculty members of the University who have signed a co-appointment agreement with the Center and shall still occupy the staffing vacancy of their affiliated unit. The term “supporting faculty members” from other academic programs refers to faculty members of the University who have not signed a co-appointment agreement with the Center.

Article 3 The selection of faculty members shall be conducted in accordance with the following procedures:

1. The Curriculum Committee of the Center determines the courses which need to be offered by other units of the University in the next academic year in accordance with curriculum planning details, current faculty qualifications, and Article 3 of the Regulations Governing the Establishment of the Center for Teacher Education.
2. The Center issues an official letter to all units of the University and calls for faculty members to instruct the courses listed in the preceding paragraph.
3. Applicants shall submit for review a course outline, a document describing their personal teaching and research achievements, and a consent form

sealed by their affiliated unit.

4. The Curriculum Committee shall review the content of the course outline submitted and the applicant's eligibility to instruct the course. Those who pass the review may be appointed as a jointly appointed or supporting faculty member.

Article 4 In principle, jointly appointed faculty members shall, under the Center, offer education cornerstone courses, education methodology courses, discipline-specific teaching materials and methods, discipline-specific internship courses, guidance of internship, and other required or required elective courses. Convener of the Discipline-Specific Course Determination Committee may be appointed as a jointly appointed faculty member of the Center.

Article 5 The Center shall sign a co-appointment agreement with all the jointly appointed faculty members and their affiliated units. The agreement shall include the duration, rights, and obligations of the joint appointment, as well as other relevant matters pertaining to the joint appointment.

Article 6 The appointment of jointly appointed faculty members shall be valid for two years, and the appointment of supporting faculty members from other academic programs shall be valid for one year.

Article 7 The rights of jointly appointed faculty members shall include:

1. A jointly appointed faculty member may be elected as committee member at the Center.
2. A jointly appointed faculty member may apply for teaching and education-related research subsidies from responsible units in the field of education through the Center.
3. A jointly appointed faculty member may enjoy priority in the use of the Center's teaching and research resources.

Article 8 Jointly appointed faculty members shall offer courses under the Center in accordance with details stipulated in the agreement during the term of joint appointment.

Article 9 Upon the termination of a joint appointment, the Center may issue the decision of non-renewal after the Curriculum Committee has confirmed that the faculty member is no longer able to fulfill their teaching obligations.

Article 10 The Regulations shall be passed by the General Education Committee of the Center for General Education, reported to the University for reference, and then implemented on the date of promulgation.
