Article 1 The Center for Teacher Education (“the Center”) under the Center for General Education, National Taiwan University (“the University”) formulates *the Regulations for the Establishment of the Center for Teacher Education Student Recruitment Committee* (“the Regulations”) and establishes its Student Recruitment Committee (“the Committee”) in accordance with Article 6 of the Center for General Education's Regulations Governing the Establishment of the Center for Teacher Education.

Article 2 The Committee shall be composed of the following members:

1. Ex officio members: The Director of the Center, the Director of the Curriculum and Instruction Division, and the Director of the Practicum and Internship Division shall serve as ex officio members.
2. Elected members: A total of 6-8 members elected from among the Center's full-time and jointly appointed faculty members shall serve as elected members, with at least one from the College of Liberal Arts, one from the College of Science, and one full-time faculty member of the Center. An additional 2-3 alternate members shall be elected to serve out the term for any vacancies that should arise. In the event that the number of elected members falls below 6, the Director of the Center for General Education shall appoint eligible members to fill the quorum.

The Director of the Center shall serve as convener and chair of the Committee.

Article 3 Committee members shall serve a term of one academic year, and may serve consecutive terms if re-elected.

Article 4 This Committee shall formulate regulations governing the recruitment of students into the Teacher Education Program, and shall organize recruitment-related affairs on a regular basis.

Article 5 The Committee may only convene with more than half of its members in

attendance, and a resolution may only be made with more than half of the attending members approving the resolution in question.

Article 6 The Regulations shall be passed by the General Education Committee of the Center for General Education, reported to the University for reference, and then implemented on the date of promulgation.
